FIRST RESPONDER

- 24 Hours of class or CEs (Continuing Education Credits)
- AED
- CPR
- Testing every 2 years

EMT-I

- 24 Hours of class or CEs (Continuing Education Credits)
- AED (Renewal within 6 months for SCCO)
- CPR
- Testing every 2 years
- Skills Competency Verification Form

IF YOUR CERTIFICATE HAS LAPSED FOR 0-6 MONTHS

- You may renew without any **ADDITIONAL** requirements.

IF YOUR CERTIFICATE HAS LAPSED BETWEEN 6-12 MONTHS

- You must complete an **ADDITIONAL** 12 hours of CEs.

IF YOUR CERTIFICATE HAS LAPSED BETWEEN 12-24 MONTHS

- You must complete an **ADDITIONAL** 24 hours of CEs..

IF YOUR CERTIFICATE HAS LAPSED OVER 24 MONTHS

- You must retake the initial EMT course.

*CEs must be from a EMS qualified agency with the CE Provider number printed on the certificate and signed by an approved instructor.
